- Plan, construct, and deliver high quality District training events to include but not limited to Area Governor/Committee Chair development, President-Elect training, Secretary-Elect training, and District Training Assembly.
- Recruit and train qualified Rotarians to serve as trainers.
- Reach out to clubs to identify their training needs and develop activities to meet those needs.
- Coordinate closely with the District leadership to ensure that team activities are meeting the leadership's expectations.
- Continually research internal and external learning and development resources and materials that will improve the effectiveness of training activities.
